HOW TO DONATE

Donating by Interac e-transfer

NOTE: Only transfers made from a personal bank account are permitted.

- Follow your bank's instructions to set-up David Grove Campaign as a payment recipient, and remit to the email: donate@davidgrove.ca
- Please include your full name, residential address and telephone number in the message box.
- Your donation will be automatically deposited into the campaign bank account, and an automated acknowledgement will be sent to you. Our Financial Agent will follow-up with you to acknowledge the donation and express our thanks.

Donating by Cheque or Cash

- Personal cheques only are accepted, made payable to: David Grove Campaign
- If you are making a cash donation, our Financial Agent or their alternate must provide you with a receipt.
- If your cash or cheque donation is greater than \$50.00, please ensure that your full name and residential address are provided to our campaign Financial Agent.

FAST FACTS about MAKING a CAMPAIGN DONATION

From the BC Local Elections Act

Who can contribute?

You must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, and a BC resident to be eligible to contribute to a local government election campaign.

- Organizations, unions and corporations are NOT ELIGIBLE to contribute.

Privacy/Transparency

- Contributions of \$50 or less may be made anonymously, and must be truly anonymous (e.g., via a donation box at an event). Individuals who provide money directly to a candidate cannot request that their contribution be listed as anonymous.
- Contributions over \$50 and less than \$100 must include the donors full name and the date of the donation.
- Contributions over \$100 must include the donor's full name, residential address and date of the donation.

Contribution Limit

- Campaign donations are limited to \$1,429.70 per individual annually.
- Contributions must be made to the Campaign Financial Agent or authorized alternative.
- The Financial Agent must record the contributor's name, residential address (PO Box or business addresses are not permitted), and the date of the donation. Elections BC will redact addresses prior to publishing.
- The Campaign Financial Agent must return ineligible contributions (those exceeding \$1,429.70, or received from an ineligible individual).
- Local election campaign contributions are not tax deductible.
